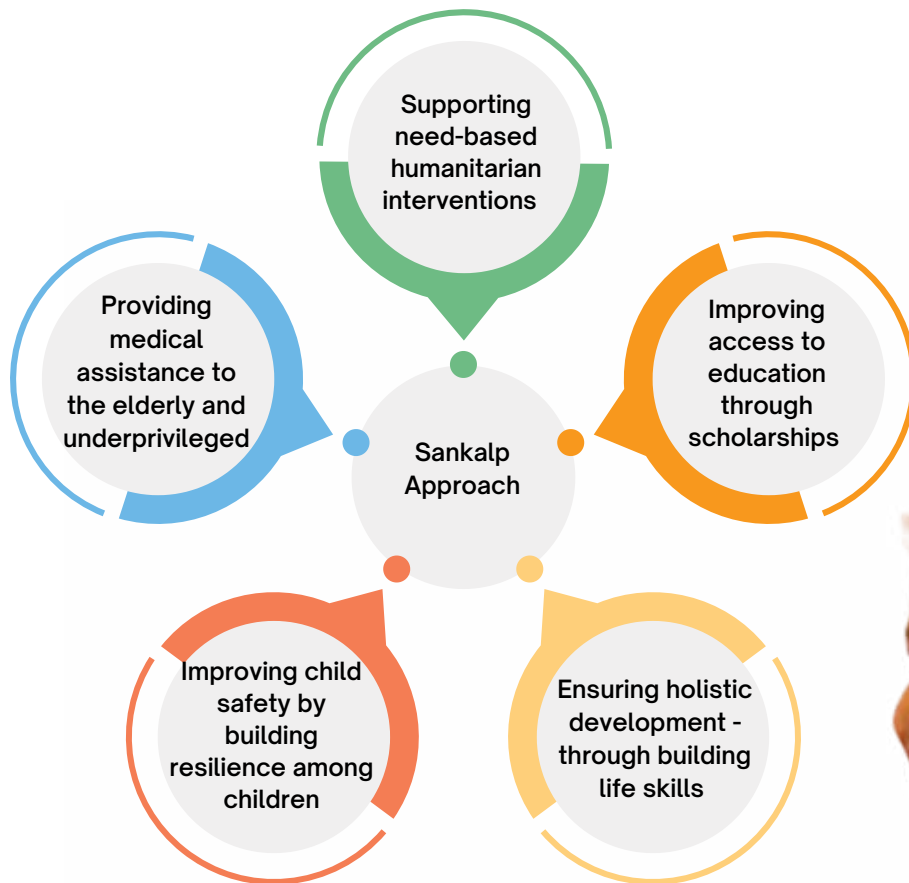

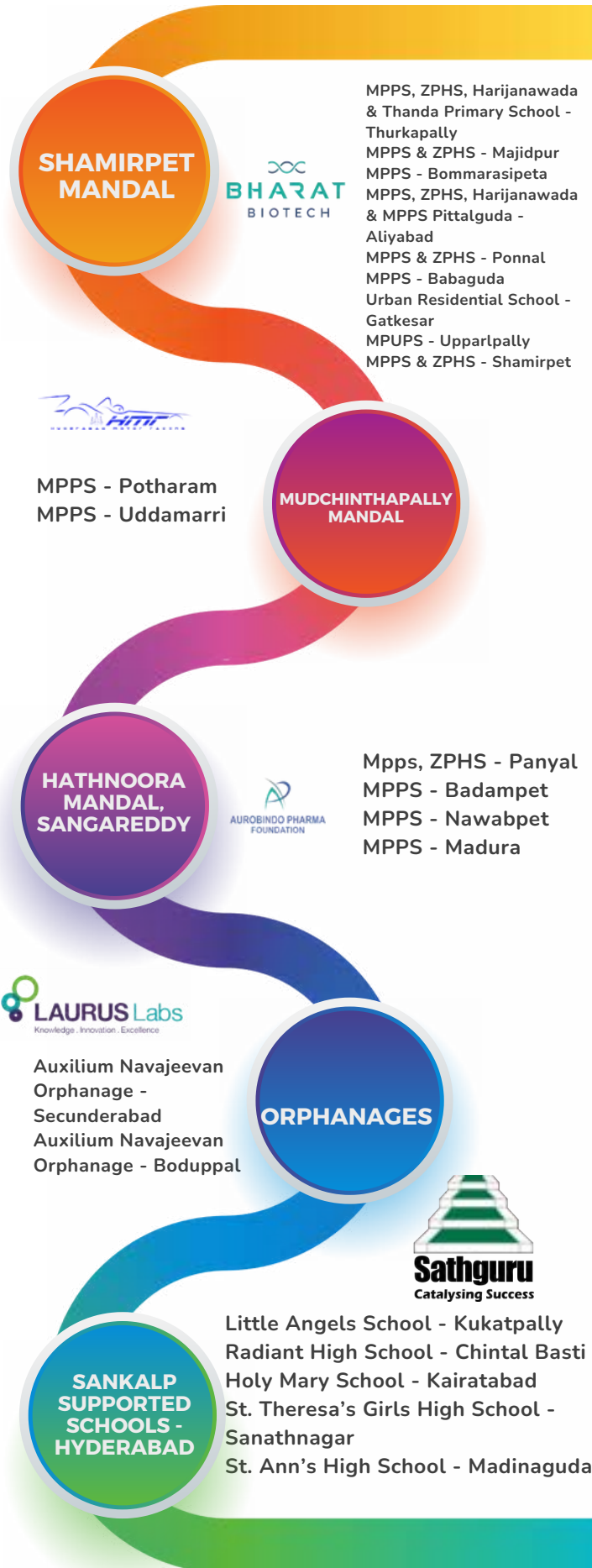

The school principals deeply appreciated Sankalp and our project sponsors for their invaluable efforts. They emphasize that these initiatives play a key role in supporting students who, due to financial constraints, might otherwise lack access to fundamental educational supplies, thereby fostering continuous education.

Prevention of child sexual abuse and life skills education:

At Sankalp, we believe every child matters. Every child has a right to be safe and protected from sexual abuse. To create a safe environment for children, Sankalp has introduced Project PANTS (P- Private parts are private, A- Always remember your body is yours), N – No means no, T – Talk to someone you trust, S – Shout, run and seek help) in a play-way method and has been reaching out to children from private and government schools in Hyderabad. Sankalp has been implementing project PANTS since 2016. This year, we have conducted awareness sessions for children from different schools in Hyderabad. We have covered five Sankalp-supporting schools in Hyderabad. We ensured that children understood the potential risks and protection strategies through the sessions conducted.

Blood Donation camp to support children battling thalassemia



Thalassemia is a rare genetic blood disorder that is carried by more than 4% of the population. A child with Thalassemia needs a regular blood transfusion every 2-5 weeks throughout their life to survive. Sankalp annually organizes blood donation camps with the key purpose of supporting blood transfusions to children suffering from cancer and thalassemia. This year Sankalp organized a blood donation camp on 27 September 2023, in association with Aarohi Blood Bank. The staff of Sathguru and neighboring corporates have enthusiastically participated in the camp. Many individuals came forward to donate blood but some were eligible and some were not eligible to donate blood because of health issues and other medical problems. Through blood donation camp we have collected 42 units of blood that have benefited 129 children. This year, in the blood donation camp, we have also set up an awareness corner to help the participants and other individuals know more about thalassemia and its symptoms and encouraged people to donate blood.



Fundraise Funfair – Empowering the underprivileged children

(Khan Paan Dukaan)

Khan Paan Dukaan is an annual fundraising food festival, organized by Sankalp Sathguru to support child education in India. With the themes Beti Bachao, Beti Padoo (Save the Child, Educate the Child), Sankalp Volunteers served food at the event, promoting child education was the primary social cause that this food festival focused on. The fundraiser served Hyderabadi, Continental, Chinese, and Indian Cuisine and an exciting live band. The culinary offerings, prepared by the dedicated team at Sathguru, not only supported the cause but also provided the staff with a fulfilling work-life balance through their involvement in cooking for a cause. A significant number of individuals took time out of their busy schedules to visit our stalls, generously contributing to support child education.

We ensured that the food at the stalls was affordable so that all the participants take part in the event. The proceeds from these sales were directed towards girl child education and the prevention of child sexual abuse.

The participants experienced a fun-filled day of delicious culinary adventures, where they had the opportunity to savor the flavors of all dishes while grooving to the beat of the live band and displayed great beyond the culinary delights, students from Sankalp-supported schools showcased their talents projects enthusiasm and willingly contributed to these noble causes. The festival saw a remarkable turnout of around 700 – 800 individuals, who generously contributed a total of 3 lakhs through food purchases and donations.

Students organized activities and fun games, adding a lively atmosphere to the event. They raised an impressive INR 1020 through these games, bringing smiles to their faces and contributing to their empowerment. This interactive event also allowed donors to connect with the children they are helping, turning the children's dreams into reality.

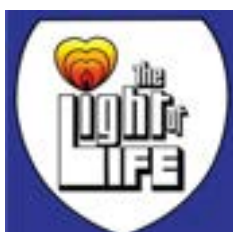
